## **BARONS RENO CHALLENGE**

### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of our basketball tournament is to provide Asian American athletes an opportunity to play and compete with other players of similar ethnic background; therefore we appreciate your support in our endeavor. Our goal is to host a competitive tournament with good sportsmanship from players, parents, and coaches. **Poor sportsmanship (e.g., trash talking, kicking benches, technical fouls, fighting, badgering referees, and “running up the score”) will affect future invitations to our tournament.**

### **ROSTERS:**

Enclosed is the roster form which **must** be completed in detail. Incomplete roster information will not be accepted. (We prefer that our form is used, however if you submit a different format please ensure all the information on our form is included.)

The division is based on grade-level. The Tournament Committee strictly enforces this policy, so please do not submit a player whose grade level is higher than the division you have been invited.

### **ROSTER CHANGES:**

Teams are selected by the Tournament Committee based on the **original roster submitted**. Therefore, roster change requests will only be considered for extreme hardship cases and must be approved by the Tournament Committee. Requests must be in writing and must include the reason for the request.

### **TEAM REPRESENTATIVES:**

Future correspondence will be made to the team representative identified on the submitted roster form.

### **ENTRY FEES:**

Rosters submitted without the \$375 entry fee would be considered invalid. Roster and entry fee must be submitted by: **July 1, 2010.**
